



# Certificate II in Rail Infrastructure

## *Mandatory Core Units - Information*

**COURSE:** The Certificate II in Rail Infrastructure (TLI21315) requires 16 units of competence to be completed to prior to being issued with a Full Certificate II. These 16 units are divided into TWO sections:

- Mandatory
- Specialised

The Rail Safety Act and Rail Safety Legislation means all Rail Infrastructure personnel working within the rail sector must attain minimum competency standards prior to carrying out work within the rail corridor.

This includes:

- Track Workers (installation and maintenance)
- Track Inspection and Examiners
- Plant and Mobile Plant Operators

The Mandatory Units are:

- TLIB1028 Maintain and use hand tools
- TLID1001 Shift materials using manual handling methods
- TLIE1003 Participate in workplace communications
- TLIF1001 Follow work health and safety procedures
- TLIF2010 Apply fatigue management strategies
- TLIU2008 Apply environmental procedures to rail infrastructure
- TLIB2085 Apply track fundamentals (ARTC/CRN only)
- TLIW2001 Operate under track protection rules (ARTC only)

**N.B** To carry out work for ARTC as a Road Rail Vehicle Operator (TMO), the mandatory units must be completed.



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## *Cost, Duration, Pre-requisites, RPL, SoA*

### DURATION:

- 1 to 2 days depending on industry experience.

### LOCATION:

- At our training facility in Chullora, NSW
- At client's premises depending on group numbers.

### COST:

- \$400 per person incl of GST.  
(minimum of 3 participants per class)

### ASSESSMENT:

- Theory
- Practical

### PRE-REQUISITES:

- Current RIW Card (evidence of successfully completing TLIF2080 Safely access the rail corridor)
- Must be able to read, write, speak and understand English.

### RECOGNISED PRIOR LEARNING (RPL):

You may be eligible for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) or Recognition of Current Competence (RCC) by providing evidence of your industry experience, previous training, references and/or other supporting documentation, you may qualify to be awarded individual units of competence, skill sets or qualification via a Gap Assessment Pathway.

### ON SUCCESSFUL COMPLETION:

You will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for the completed units.
