

ROAD RAIL PLANT OPERATOR (TMO)



Course:

This nationally accredited course is designed to provide 'hands on' training to drivers and operators of:

- Track machines (hi-rail plant)
- Road/rail vehicles (4 wheel drives & trucks)
- Light on track equipment (clipping machines & motorised track jacks)

Participants will learn the requirements, rules and procedures applicable when performing tasks during *Local Possession Authority (LPA)* or a *Track Occupancy Authority (TOA)*.

Duration: One day

Price: \$550 incl of GST
\$350 incl of GST for recertification

Location: Chullora, followed by a short drive to Chullora siding's yard to undertake the practical assessment.

Vehicle: SCCRT can provide our own manual vehicle (light to medium) for training purposes or you can provide your own.

Assessment: Participants must pass a written and practical assessment to be deemed competent.

Recertification: Recertification is every 5 years and consists of a half day theory course before card expiry date with a current medical.

Requirements:

- Current RIW Card
- Category One (1) Medical
- Current Driver's License for the type of vehicle/machinery you will be operating
- For ARTC only; participants must hold competency in the Mandatory Core Units from Certificate II in Rail Infrastructure. (Arrangements can be made should you require training in these units).

On completion:

Upon successful completion, the participant will receive a *Statement of Attainment* recognising the following competencies:

- TLIC2058 Travel medium or heavy self-propelled on-track equipment
- TLIC2059 Propel and operate light on-track equipment
- TLIC3045 Operate road/rail vehicle
- TLIC2054 Access rail track to run track vehicle within a defined worksite
